



Middle School Student Ministry -Intern

Reports to: Campus Pastor

Works closely with: Central Student Ministry Director, Campus Student Point Director, Family Ministry Team

Job Description

The Middle School Student Point Director works with the Campus Pastor, the Campus Student Ministry Director and the Family Ministry Team to create and lead Middle School Student Ministry programs and activities. Accepted candidates will have to successfully complete a background check.

Primary Responsibilities

The Middle School Student Director position at The Point Church encompasses the following areas of responsibility:

1. Student Ministry Sunday Morning Program - Work closely with the Central Student Ministry Director and Campus Student Ministry Director to plan and lead Sunday morning programs for students at your campus. The content and structure are provided centrally but are implemented at the campus level with the church pastor.
2. Middle School Students - Focus on developing aspects of the Middle School Student Ministry Program to meet the needs of these students including: teaching, fellowship opportunities, conferences, retreats and mission trips at the respective church.
3. Parent Education/Support - Work with the Central Student Ministry Director and the Student Ministry Director to develop ways to equip, educate and support parents of middle school students in leading their children as their primary faith trainers. The Middle School Director works in line with the Family Discipleship Plan to help parents walk through Spiritual Stages with their children. This may include teaching parent workshops, providing parent resources and communicating with parents on a monthly basis in collaboration with our Family Ministry Team.
4. Sunday Morning Student Ministry Representative - The Middle School Director worships on Sunday mornings with his church, spending time building relationships with students and their parents, as well as welcoming and connecting with visitors who have middle and high school age children. The Director maintains a strong relationship with the church pastor and works together with the pastor to assimilate and disciple families as they come to church.
5. Core Groups - Organize and lead Middle School Student core groups.
6. Global or Domestic Mission Trip – If time allows, organize and/or participate in domestic or global mission trips for students and their parents.
7. Family Ministry Team Member - The Director collaborates with the Family Ministry Team to develop Parent Training Day and additional family ministry opportunities.
8. Develop Student Leaders - Identify, train, and equip leaders within the Middle School Ministry to lead life groups and core groups.
9. All Campus Events - Participate in all campus events and serve with the students in the Student Ministry. The Campus Middle School Director is a part of Family Ministry Team. This team consists of Kid Point, Student Point and College Point. The vision of Family Ministry is that these components are all part of ONE ministry, not separate ministries.

10. Meet twice per month with your Campus Pastor and once per month with the Central Student Point Director for coaching, goal setting, brainstorming and assessment.

The primary way that Middle School Student Ministry will be fulfilled is through the Middle School Director identifying, recruiting, training, equipping and encouraging volunteers to use their spiritual gifts to fulfill the mission of the church.

“It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.” Ephesians 4:11.

Other Responsibilities

1. Participate in the life of the church; i.e., Life Group, Core Group, Worship, giving of time, treasure (10% of income) and talent. These things are expected of every staff member and must be modeled.
2. Participate in all scheduled staff meetings and staff development times.
3. Continue honing of ministry skills.
4. Complete duties in a timely manner as set by your campus pastor
5. Agree to and support *The Point Church Statement of Faith* as stated in the church *Bylaws*.
6. Agree to abide by *The Point Church Staff Policy Manual*.
7. Abide by budget allocations.
8. Report monthly the status and health of assigned campus ministries.
9. Spend time daily in prayer and study God's Word so that you can be in a position to lead others out of a growing relationship with Christ.

4. Ability to reach and disciple people for Jesus Christ not only in the church but in the community as well.
5. Ability to train and lead volunteers in team ministry.
6. Ability to do cross-cultural ministry.
7. Ability to work well with others.
8. Ability to maintain positive speech and attitude.
9. Ability to believe the best about others.
10. Ability to avoid gossip and to resolve conflict biblically (Matt 18:15-17).
