

Introduction: This week we heard how black lives more than matter to God. Below are some of the passages from the message.

Intro question: What is something that stood out to you from the message this week? What is one takeaway you had?

Acts 17:26 GNT “From one human being he created all races of people and made them live throughout the whole earth. He himself fixed beforehand the exact times and the limits of the places where they would live.”

Q: Have you ever considered that God intentionally created diverse races? How does this affect our approach to our differences?

Revelation 5:9-10 “And they sang a new song, saying, ‘Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation, and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth.’”

Q: This is a vision of heaven. What stands out to you from this passage?

Q: What application does this vision of heaven have for the present?

Q: Are there any divisions of tribe, language, people, and nation in God’s kingdom? How can God’s people be a unifying force in the world?

Galatians 6:10 “Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.”

1 John 3:18 “... let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.”

Q: How do these passages specifically challenge you as you approach racism?

Q: What are some specific actions you can take to love others from another race?
